TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SUPPLY

THE FOLLOWING, WHEN ACCEPTED BY YOU (WHETHER AS AN INDIVIDUAL, OR IF APPLICABLE, ACTING AS THE REPRESENTATIVE OF A COMPANY, CORPORATION OR OTHER ENTITY) SHALL CONSTITUTE YOUR AGREEMENT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET OUT BELOW. PLEASE READ THIS AGREEMENT CAREFULLY. BY SIGNING UP AND ACCESSING THE SERVICE, YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS. IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, YOU MAY NOT SIGN UP OR USE THE SERVICE.

DEFINITIONS “We”, “us”, or “eCom” shall refer to eCom USA Learning Solutions, LLC is a Georgia limited liability company founded in 2014, eCom USA Learning Solutions, LLC is a subsidiary of eCom Scotland Limited.

“You” means you individually, and if you are representing an organisation, it also includes the organisation that you represent.

“Service”, “Services”, shall refer to all services offered by eCom under any agreement between you and eCom as well as the eNet Applications OnDemand, including but not limited to eNetReality™.

“Agreement” shall refer to this Acceptable Use Policy Agreement

“Enrolees” referred to in this agreement are any users of the application. Each User requires a user license to accessed the service via a unique email address and secure password.

“Administrator” is a User who has been appointed by the company to manage their account, by creating users and defining and modifying roles.

“Laws” shall mean all applicable laws, rules, regulations, and ordinances in force in the jurisdiction where you use the services, as well as all laws, rules, regulations, and ordinances in force in the jurisdiction where any person or entity may access the services under your license.

A “Cookie” is a small amount of data, which often includes a unique identifier that is sent to your Device via an application or web browser from a website's computer and stored on your device's hard drive.

“Device” shall mean any electronic device, including but not limited to a personal computer, server, phone, tablet, or other similar device used to access the Services.

ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

Everyone who uses the Services, including trial versions of the Services or any part thereof, shall be bound by this Agreement. If you do not agree to the terms and conditions set forth, then you should not access or use the Service. By registering for the service you are acknowledging you have read and understood and agree to be bound by this agreement.

GENERAL INFORMATION

eCom uses “Cookies” to improve the website experience and to support users by remembering logins and passwords.

There are a number of different “Cookies” that eCom uses:

Web browser and email cookies

Each website can send its own cookie to your web browser if your browser's preferences allow it. This is done whenever a user visits the website in order to track online traffic flows. eCom uses similar technologies within particular emails to understand whether the email has been read or if any links have been clicked. If you continue without changing your settings, eCom will assume that you are happy to receive all cookies on the website and via email. You may change your cookie settings in your web browser and your email provider, however, this may affect or limit the way in which you are able to interact with eCom and may affect your ability to access or use the Services.

When you visit an eCom website, cookies record information about your online preferences and allow us to tailor our websites to your interests.

Information supplied by cookies helps eCom to understand the profile of its visitors to provide them with a better user experience. It also helps recognise when you are signed in to your eCom or eNet account and to provide a more personalised experience.

To support our content, we sometimes embed content from social media and other third party websites. These may include YouTube, Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, Pinterest, Flickr etc . As a result, when you visit a page containing such content, you may be presented with cookies from these websites and these third party cookies may track your use of the eCom website. eCom does not control the dissemination of these cookies and you should check the relevant third party's website for more information. If you continue without changing your settings, we'll assume that you are happy to receive all cookies on the website.

It is important to note that if you change your settings and block certain cookies, you will not be able to take full advantage of some features of eCom services, and we might not be able to provide some features you have previously chosen to receive.

We do not use any of the specific information collected by cookies, nor do we disclose the information to third parties, except where required by law (for example to government bodies and law enforcement agencies). We do use the aggregate data for statistical reasons and only where no individual can be recognised. By continuing to access our site, you are consenting to our use of cookies.

However, if you do wish to disable our cookies then we would recommend that you change your cookie settings via your browser; your browser help function will tell you how.
